Trainees will have the opportunity to test for certifications in concrete, soils and aggregate compaction, safety and flagging, and pavement marking. This 8-week program equips job seekers with new skills that are in demand, creating employment and strengthening the community.

- Must be independently capable of getting to the training and testing sites in Southwest DC and various locations in Maryland and Virginia
